CAMP FEATURES

WHEN WE MEET... There are 2 weeks of camp available in Mahwah... Week of 7/15 and the Week of 7/29. Both weeks meets Monday thru Thursday from 9:00AM—1:00PM. Friday is a rain date.

WHERE WE MEET... both the Minors Program and the Majors Program meet at Continental Soldiers Park. (550 Ramapo Valley Rd. Mahwah, NJ 07430)

LUNCH... We break for a quick lunch of apx 25 minutes. PBI does not provide lunch. So please pack a light lunch for your child.

ITEMS TO BRING... Baseball glove, bat, batting gloves, baseball hat, wear appropriate baseball clothing, lunch.

GROUPING OF STUDENTS... PBI will be dividing the students into age & skill groups. Students will first be grouped by age, then may be moved according to skill level. Each group will be trained to match their skill level. We will not group 8 year olds with 12 year olds. PBI has a maximum 8:1 student-to-coach ratio.

HITTING- PBI uses the latest, most effective hitting products available. Students will travel thru dozens of hitting stations; each station emphasizes a different facet of the swing mechanics. We will perform innovative drills to increase your chances of hitting the ball on the "sweet spot"... consistently. Our hitting stations, when performed properly, create positive muscle memory, effectively reinforcing good habits while replacing poor habits with good habits. Live hitting will also be part of the program. PBI's hitting program has been designed with the help of current Pittsburgh Pirates Major League Manager Clint Hurdle and has been recognized as 5 STAR by former San Francisco Giants Manager Felipe Alou.

PITCHING- PBI knows pitching! We have one of the finest pitching programs in the Nation!! By far the best in NJ! Our innovative "Building Blocks" teaching program has developed top-level pitchers and will have your child throwing strikes consistently. Students will be educated to the pitching mechanics and how they relate to each pitch. Topics include: mechanics, pitch grips, mental game, pitchers fielding practice, live throwing & much more. Pitching: a complex theory and understanding broken into simple to comprehend drills and teaching. PBI's pitching programs are designed with the help of legendary Major League pitching coach Leo Mazzone.

INFIELD— Our extremely qualified infield staff of over 20 years pro playing experience will bring your child on an incredible journey "around the horn", teaching all the "secrets" of infield play along the way. Students will learn and sharpen fielding fundamentals and then move onto more intermediate and advanced skill-work, including backhands, forehands, short hops, long hops, double plays, making tags, and learn how to consistently field "thru the ball" which is vital to being a solid infielder. Long time Major League Manager/coach Sam Perlozzo and current Cleveland Indians major leaguer Mike Aviles constantly keep PBI on the cutting edge of training for fielders.

OUTFIELD- Proper technique is crucial to being an outfielder. Our professional staff will teach the techniques of solid outfield play. Students learn and polish their outfield skills such as fielding ground balls and fly balls, getting a good 'angle' to balls that are in the 'gap', and creating a good rhythm to field and make a strong accurate throw back into the infield. With outfield mentors like Larry Walker, Jeremy Burnitz, Marquis Grissom and Steve Finley, it's crystal clear why PBI is #1 in New Jersey.

CATCHING- The most demanding position on the field. To be a catcher requires skill and courage, so it's important to learn the position the correct way. PBI knows this and has a program tailored by pro catchers to help teach the youth of America. For the players whom choose to catch, they will work on the following skills: throwing skills, receiving pitches, blocking balls in the dirt, footwork, firing out, fielding bunts & throwing to all bases.

BASERUNNING- A team with good baserunning skills is always a threat. Once again our experience as professional players give us the advantage. Players will travel around the bases working on all the skills needed to run the bases well and intelligently. Home to 1B, baserunning from 2B & 3B, getting a good 'turn', extra base hits, tagging up, secondary leads, getting a good jump, and leading (for our 50/70 — 60/90 players).

SLIDING- Studies indicate that most injuries on the baseball field occur while sliding! These injuries can be easily avoided. Once again, PBI's professional staff has the experience. <u>Registration</u>— Register at www.TMYSB.org. Upon registration, you must complete a health history form and sign the hold harmless and agreements.

Medical & Insurance Info PBI provides medical and liability insurance for all campers.

Transportation PBI does NOT provide transportation.

Camp Fees— Pre-Paid students pay \$249. per week. Our Family Plan allows for a \$10. deduction of the camp fee for any additional sibling.

<u>Late Registration</u>— A late registration fee of \$25. will be incurred when registering the morning of the camp.

Weather— Call 1-800-282-4638 ext 7 in the event of questionable weather for a recording with weather related updates. In the event camp needs to be cancelled due to weather; we will typically make a decision by 8:15_{AM}. On occasion, depending upon the specific situation, we may not make a decision until later. Fields must be in good condition to avoid possible injuries.



REFUND POLICIES & HOLD HARMLESS

Refund Policies— There are NO cash refunds. Any student missing camp time - regardless of the reason - will be issued a credit voucher minus a \$50 administrative fee. Vouchers have no expiration date, and can be used toward any future PBI clinic or camp program.

<u>Make-Up Time</u>— You will be expected to attend the program you signed up for. PBI cannot guarantee the ability to accommodate changes made after your program has begun. Make-ups will not be provided for missed class time unless the missed class time is due a weather cancellation.
